DEMAND AN END TO PATIENT DUMPING

Woman Tried To Save Man Found Dead Under Bridge Near Scripps Hospital In Hillcrest

SAN DIEGO (KGTV) – A woman says she tried to save the life of a man found dead under a bridge this morning. He was released from the hospital just hours before police found his body in Hillcrest. - Mar 8, 2018

Across the state, irresponsible hospitals dump homeless patients in the streets. This results in further illness and sometimes death.

California Senate Bill 1152 will end the cruel practice of homeless patient dumping by establishing minimum standards for how hospitals should discharge homeless individuals. This includes ensuring homeless patients are not discharged in hospital gowns to unknown locations.
